

Starting in 2014, Colibri has provided several apps to Eastern Connecticut State University that replaced legacy solutions used by Police, Housing, and Student Activities.

Colibri replaced an old MS Access database for campus police with a new app named *Campus Park*, a permit parking and iPad-based ticketing system that handles thousands of violations per year and saves countless hours in data entry and reporting using *Campus Park*.

Since 2015, Eastern has used *eLife*, an application that combines the functionality of multiple apps into a single app that integrates with the Ellucian Banner student information system. *eLife* provides a secure, modern application with a host of new functionality. Almost 200 users interact with eLife daily.

eLife manages student housing, student activities, programs, and the university's Center for Community Engagement (CCE). eLife manages programs whose registration is enabled through integration with eWeb, the Campus intranet. eLife's scheduling tool improves transportation efforts, and we use WebDirect technology to gather event attendance using mobile browsers.



Featherstone Design: Time To Create

Featherstone Design is a platinum jewelry design company in New York City. Their studio was badly damaged by flooding during Hurricane Sandy, and they realized they needed a more secure data management environment. They came to Colibri through a FileMaker event at the SoHo Apple store.

Before working with Colibri, the studio kept their proprietary jewelry design details on paper notecards. Their inventory was listed in an obsolete management solution. It took up to 3 hours to prepare an insurance appraisal. CRM data was maintained in a separate app, making marketing communications cumbersome.

Their new custom FileMaker app integrates the design, inventory and customer data, and Colibri Solutions developed templates to produce appraisals and invoices automatically. And their recent move to the cloud lets everyone at Featherstone work from anywhere.

The Featherstone Design team felt the impact immediately once their administrative burden was dramatically reduced and Ms. Featherstone and her team are enjoying new levels of creativity.



GoodWeave: A Better World For Children

GoodWeave is an international NGO working to end illegal child labor in the carpet industry in South Asia and offering education to children rescued from the carpet looms. Retailers can guarantee to consumers that no children were exploited or enslaved to make carpets that carry the GoodWeave label.

GoodWeave Founder Kailash Satyarthi was awarded the 2014 Nobel Peace Prize.

Colibri developed a management system that combines fundraising with GoodWeave's unique trademark licensing and invoicing processes.

More recently, Colibri has worked with GoodWeave's international staff to manage and transfer field operations data to headquarters in Washington DC.

Since 2000, Colibri and the FileMaker Platform have been in a partner in the growth of GoodWeave's operations and donor base. GoodWeave has reduced child labor in the carpet industry by 75%, and we are proud to have played a small part in that success.
